New Feature Highlights

Upgrade to AngularJS 1.8.5

AngularJS is a JavaScript-based open-source front-end web framework for developing single-page applications. It is maintained mainly by Google and a community of individuals and corporations. Customers will be concerned about AngularJS going end-of-life at the end of 2021. It may get flagged during an evaluation or a security review. BeyondTrust has contracted with XLTS.dev to provide extended support for our applications to ensure our products stay secure and supported. The 3.4 release will be the first release to use the new extended support code base.

Customer Entry of Windows and SQL Keys

Appliance images built by BeyondTrust are pre-licensed for the customer. In the future, to facilitate faster fulfillment times, we may start working from a single gold image and provide the required license keys to the customer directly. The 3.4 release on an unlicensed image displays a prompt for the required license keys. This step can be skipped to enable a 60-day trial period. New license keys can be entered in Maintenance.

New Diagnostics Counter for Memory (RAM) Usage

Based upon popular request from our customers, we have added an additional counter to the Diagnostics page to show the amount of RAM being used at the time.

- Migration of Image Post-Deploy Script steps into the Configuration Wizard
- Retirement of managing Enterprise Update Server credentials in Maintenance
- Two new Hardening Override Settings (IPv6 and Hardened UNC Paths)
