


# Privilege Management Console *(formerly iC3)*

## New and Updated Features

BeyondTrust's Privilege Management Console (PMC) gives you the ultimate in intelligent communication, coordination, and control of your Privilege Management protected endpoints. Manage the removal of admin rights, achieve least privilege and pro-actively manage endpoint security. PMC gives you an always-on, scalable platform to grow with your business, with a wealth on insight to ensure you're managing your policy as effectively as possible.

This release includes the product rebranded from iC3 to Privilege Management Console, or PMC. Alongside new branding, key changes include integration with the latest version of Reporting, database performance improvements and improved support for Mac endpoints.

## New Feature Highlights

### Reporting 5.4 SR1 Support

PMC 2.3 now supports the latest version of Reporting, 5.4 SR1. Support in the previous 2.2 version was for Reporting 5.1 SR1.

Reporting 5.4 SR1 allows you to view Power Rules in the Events > All and Events > Process Detail reports. There is also support for new Mac events, including reporting on installs and uninstalls in the /Applications folder.

Reporting 5.4 SR1 also includes numerous performance and bug fixes.

### Disabled Auto-Deactivation by Default

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This release disables auto-deactivation by default (previously, it was enabled by default).

Once deactivated, endpoints cannot be reactivated. This change minimizes the likelihood of endpoints being deactivated unintentionally.

Please note, PMC administrators can choose to enable auto-deactivation for their estate in the PMC interface, if required.

### Database Performance Improvements

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The management and reporting database within PMC have index improvements in this release for Azure PaaS.

These changes have been made as continued performance improvements to ensure the ongoing scalability of the PMC product. They help with managing a large number of endpoints and viewing reports with a high volume of data.

### Other Enhancements/Fixes

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- The Privilege Management client's last connected date for Windows is updated correctly on each connection
- Mac logs can now be retrieved from the PMC interface (known issue in 2.2)
- Fixed time zone issues in several reports
- Various rebranding elements and EULA updates
