

Privilege Management ePO Extension 22.7 Release Notes

September 22, 2022

New Features and Enhancements:

- Application's matching criteria can now be configured in policy using the SHA-256 hash. It is also available to be passed via an event using **Add to Policy** and is reportable on the **Event Details** screen within **Reports**.
- Added the ability to configure the staging task by specifying the number of events contained per batch to be transferred from ePO to Privilege Management Reporting.

- Privilege Management Mac Client **22.7 (recommended)**, 21.1 (minimum)
- Privilege Management Reporting **22.5 (recommended)**, 21.1 (minimum)

 - Safari v10 and higher
 - Chrome (latest version)
 - Firefox (latest version)
