

Privilege Management ePO Extension 5.7 SR1 Release Notes

Issues Resolved:

- Resolved issue for policy approval of **My Default** for admin approval after update.



Note:

- Fresh installations (any version) are not affected and can be upgraded.
- This only occurs if you have previously upgraded to version 5.6 or 5.7.
- If you do not use policy approval you are not affected.
- The issue only affects the **My Default** policy and requires policy approval to be enabled for admins.
- Once the problem has appeared, the issue cannot be resolved via an upgrade.
- You can workaround the issue by not using the **My Default** policy.
- To fully resolve the issue in this case you will need to uninstall and re-install the signed version.
- Remember to export existing policies and make a note of policy assignment in this case.

- Mac Add to Policy now works properly.
- This update no longer precompiles JSPs for future ePO compatibility.
- Resolved ePO 5.10 update 10 compatibility issue.

Compatibility:

- Privilege Management Windows Client 5.7 (recommended), 3.8+



Note: Privilege Management for Windows client 5.5.144 GA is certified with ePO Server 5.9 and 5.10.

- Privilege Management Mac Client 5.6 (recommended), 5.2.29409.0 SR1, 5.2.27899.0 GA



Note: Privilege Management for Mac client 5.5.5 GA is certified with ePO Server 5.9 and 5.10; 5.2.29409.0 SR1 is certified with ePO Server 5.10.

- Privilege Management Reporting 5.7 SR1 (recommended), 5.5+



Note: If you are using an older version of the Privilege Management Reporting database, some reports may not return data, and some levels of performance may be reduced.

Using ePO to query fields or import events that contain fields that are not present in the Privilege Management Reporting database causes errors to be displayed. Fields will not be present in the Privilege Management Reporting database if the functionality was implemented in a subsequent release.

Note: If the version of McAfee MOVE is compatible with the McAfee Agent you are using, then Privilege Management is also compatible.
